Incidents

Sergeant Corrigan, a Captain in the US Air Force Reserves was deployed to Puerto Rico to aid in the relief efforts from the devastation of Hurricane Maria.

At approximately 4:46 p.m. on Friday, Oct. 27, a Maynard Police officer conducted a traffic stop after he observed a vehicle speeding on Acton Street. The passenger, **DUSHANEK**, was known to have an active warrant for his arrest and subsequently fled upon being identified by the officer conducting the stop. **DUSHANEK** fled into the nearby woods behind the Massachusetts State Police (MSP) Crime Lab and eventually made his way into Acton, where Acton Police, the MSP Air Wing and the Belmont Police Department K-9 Unit joined the search effort. As the search continued, commuter rail train service was briefly suspended after **DUSHANEK** was spotted near the Acton train station. Police then pinged **DUSHANEK'S** phone and narrowed his location to the area of Liberty Street, and the MSP Air Wing subsequently observed him running through yards near homes on Maple Street. Maynard, Acton and State Police then established a perimeter and took **DUSHANEK** into custody without further incident at approximately 7:30 p.m. near a home on Lothrop Street in Acton. **DUSHANEK** was then booked by the Maynard Police Department and subsequently transported to the Billerica House of Correction, where he was held until his arraignment.

A special thank you to the Massachusetts State Police, Acton Police, Belmont Police K9, Boxborough Police, and Stow Police Departments for assistance in this multi agency search.

On October 30th, we experienced a fairly significant rain and wind storm. During this storm we briefly lost our power, phone, internet, and cable. We were running on the generator for several hours, without issue. The phone, internet and cable were eventually restored. Throughout the storm our E911 system remained functioning and residents were informed to call 911 if they were in need of Police/Fire/EMS. The Maynard Police Department, Fire Department and DPW responded to numerous calls for wires and trees down. Great work by all!
