Incidents

There have been numerous reports of unemployment fraud. Please continue to report these incidents to the Maynard Police Department.

On September 3rd, 2020 an individual reported their elderly parent was missing from the residence. Officers from the Maynard and Acton Police Departments responded to search the area, and the individual was located and transported to the hospital for an evaluation.

On September 12th during the overnight hours Officers located a ladder propped against the Green Meadow School. There was no entry made into the school, incident was documented, and the facilities department was contacted. It was determined it may have been left by a company working on the building.

On September 30th, a motor vehicle was reported as stolen to the Maynard Police Department after it was not returned to a rental agency. The vehicle was entered as stolen into the database, and later recovered by a New York agency.
