On January 1st, Officers responded to a business to Euclid Avenue for a report of a possible B&E to the building and destruction to the property. The matter is under investigation.

On January 4th, Officers responded to the parking lot of Market Basket for a report of a car accident involving 5 vehicles. The Fire Department evaluated those involved in the accident, and no one was transported.
