On August 2<sup>nd</sup>, while on routine patrol the Sergeant discovered what appeared to be new damage to the building. The damage and graffiti were documented, and the property owner was notified.

On August 5<sup>th</sup>, Officers responded to a residence on Lewis Street where a tree had fallen on the house. Officers and the Fire Department spoke with the resident who had contacted insurance. Photographs were taken of the damage, a report was filed, and the resident was advised to contact us in the event she had further concerns.

On August 15<sup>th</sup> while on routine patrol an Officer observed damage to several flowerpots that appeared to have been pushed off the banister in front of a Main Street business. The business owner was notified, and Officers were checking for cameras in the surrounding area.

On August 16<sup>th</sup>, Officers responded to Nason Street, where two businesses reported property damage and vandalism to a front door and signage. Officers are reviewing camera footage and the matter is under investigation.
